WHEREAS, public procurement is an essential function of state government, providing for the purchase of goods and services necessary for the safe and effective operations of the state, including purchases for education, health and human services, transportation, administration, and others; and

WHEREAS, the work of the state procurement office benefits state agencies and citizens alike through the application of the principles of fiscal responsibility and ethical use of taxpayer dollars for the operations of the state; and

WHEREAS, public procurement professionals require specific knowledge and skills to maintain fair and competitive bid practices, conduct thorough market research, administer effective negotiations for the mutual benefit of the state and supplier, and successfully monitor and evaluate all state contracts; and

WHEREAS, the State of Idaho is supported by a highly qualified and dedicated state procurement staff who demonstrate professionalism on all levels and understand the importance of the work they perform; and

WHEREAS, it is important for all citizens and state employees to familiarize themselves with the activities required in providing quality, ethical purchases for our state, and the effort the Idaho Procurement Office puts forward every day ensures these activities are carried out with the utmost professionalism; and

WHEREAS, the month of March has been designed as National Procurement Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRAD LITTLE, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim March 11, 2023, to be

in Idaho, and I encourage Idaho citizens to recognize this special observance.
